Qualified applicants must demonstrate

- Minimum of 3 years teaching experience
- Master's degree, minimum GPA of 3.0
- NYS Permanent or Professional Teacher Certification
- Principal endorsement
- Access to a school-based decision making team

Application Tips

1. **Under Program of Study:** Select School of Education – Other Programs and Educational Leadership (SBL/SDL)
2. **Statement of Purpose:** Your statement should address (1) your interest in the CLASS program; (2) your ability to participate in a school-based decision making team
3. **Letters of Recommendation:** One of the letters must be from your current school principal. Your principal must endorse your participation on a school-based decision making team, and address your ability to complete an internship at your school site
4. **Interview:** Eligible candidates will be invited to an interview in mid-November
